- -Sharing stories over food,
- -Talking about how identity is connected with your sexual health,
- -Different rights or justice issues,
- -Realities in our Indigenous communities and why sexual and reproductive healths are important
- -Anything you can imagine!

What are the rules?

- Videos need to be less than 3 minutes in length.
- Videos that contain nudity, offensive language/ imagery, and/or any inappropriate or discriminatory content will not be accepted.
- Videos must be submitted via email to admin@cfsh.ca by January 31st 2013.
- Submission emails must include your name, gender pronoun (or how you refer to yourself in your Indigenous language(s)), contact information and a YouTube link to your video.
